If a student and/or parent disrupts the safety of other students in the class they will be asked to leave without refund. All students and parents must show respect to the property of others. Any intentional damage to or theft of such property or class equipment will not be tolerated and could result in dismissal from the academy. All VRBA instructors will make sure the classroom is a safe environment by upholding these rules and regulations. If a student does not abide by these rules they may be asked to discontinue dance classes until they can use appropriate behavior. At any time, we reserve the right to refuse service based on the above mentioned.
